



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS, GUARDIANS, AND SUPPORTERS

Colwyn Netball Club, in its continuing effort to increase the enjoyment and participation of the game of Netball has introduced a code of conduct.

We ask all those involved in netball to follow these to ensure all games and tournaments are played in the best spirit of the game.

1. Encourage your child to play within the rules and to respect decisions made by coaches and officials, at all times
2. Teach your child that honest effort is more important than victory, so the result of the game is accepted without undue disappointment
3. Be a positive role model to your child by helping them work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship
4. Remember children learn best by example, applaud good play by your team and the opposition
5. Do not question the umpire's decisions or honesty, remember they are only human with the same feelings as you and can sometimes make mistakes
6. Recognise the importance and value to coaches and committee members who are all volunteers who give up their time to provide netball for your child
7. Familiarise yourself with the rules of netball to understand better what you are watching and commenting on
8. As a parent/guardian I will not interfere with the decisions of the officials, use inappropriate language or harass other players, coaches or officials
9. I will not criticise or ridicule my child for making mistakes or losing
10. If you have cause for concern, please do not hesitate to approach a member of the Committee.
