



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS

Colwyn Netball Club, in its continuing effort to increase the enjoyment and participation of the game of Netball has introduced a Code of Conduct.

We ask all players to follow these guidelines to ensure that all games and tournaments are played in the best spirit of the game.

1. Know and observe the rules of the game
2. Play fairly, be competitive but not aggressive
3. During play, do not question a decision made by the umpires either by gesture, look, verbally or by commenting to another player
4. Be a positive role model. Treat other players and officials with the same level of respect you would expect to be shown to you
5. Recognise fair play and applaud the good performances of all – including the opposition
6. Keep yourself under control at all times and do not retaliate. Do not use inappropriate or bad language at any time
7. Understand that competition is about winning AND losing so accept results without any undue disappointment
8. Shake hands with your opponents at the end of the match and thank the umpires for officiating
9. Members must wear appropriate kit and footwear.
10. Fingernails should be short, false nails are not acceptable.
11. No jewellery (except wedding bands) should be worn and hair should be tied back for both training and matches in accordance with the rules of netball.
12. The use of mobile phones during training or matches is unacceptable
